

## **RAJADHANI** VASTU **CONFIGU-RATION**


should be exactly aligned East/West, North/South with an auspicious eastern entrance, and be marked by a good quality fence (of even number of posts) of at least 0.72 m height. The remaining Vastu ground should be levelled with slight slope to east or north-east and be made into a beautiful garden with fountains in the east.

Vastu measurements are to be taken inside the fence. Posts and fence should be outside of these dimensions. Number of posts on each side should be even, in order to avoid post on center line of Vastu.

RAJADHANI GARDEN This particular Vastu is laid-out as a royal garden of seven enclosures (see dimensions indicated) marked by evergreen hedges. It has a central Brahmasthan square, which is a marble plated cube of 1.98x1.98m and 54 cm high. Even though it is accessible by cars, we should only allow electric (or hybrid) vehicles into the Vastu.


Entrance into Vastu should be on the north of center line, as indicated. Avoid post on center line. Suggest a triple gate arrangement with northern part openable only.

## **MINIMUM VASTU CONFIGURATION**

Vastu measurements are to be taken inside the fence. Posts and fence should be outside of these dimensions. Number of posts on each side should be even, in order to avoid post on center line of Vastu.
